Bishop Bechara Peter Rai of Jbeil (Byblos) **The Patriarch 77 of the Maronite Church**

Tuesday March 15, 2011 at 10: 30 am Church bells rang, horns blasted and firecrackers echoed throughout Lebanon as it was announced that, Lebanon, had been elected the new patriarch of the Maronite Catholic Church.

Patriarch Rai, 71, known for his courage to speak the truth, is seen as someone who can unite Maronite Catholics, who have been divided among political party lines.

The patriarch's election was announced March 15. Elections began March 11, after the Maronite synod spent two days in spiritual retreat and reflection. He replaces Cardinal Nasrallah P. Sfeir, 90, who retired because of age.

The new patriarch has served as president of the Lebanese bishops' communications committee and hosted a weekly program on Telumiere, Lebanon's Christian television station. The program, "Boushra al Rahi," which means "Good News of the Shepherd," provided commentary and teaching on that Sunday's Gospel, and the patriarch encouraged listeners to live the Scriptures in a practical way.

Our prayers and thoughts for him to lead and guide the Maronite Church worldwide in the spirit of unity and love of God. We congratulate ourselves on this historic event in our church.

Below read the letter from Bishop Gregory Mansour: **My Dear People**

Every year I appeal to you to assist in our many Eparchial services. Over the years you have responded generously because you know that together we can do so much more than we can do alone.

Together we train our seminarians (4 of them) and support our retired priests (14 of them), we have developed programs and catechetical texts for our children and youth, we have retreats for our deacons and subdeacons. We have formed a network of pro-life volunteers and couples to help fortify marriage. We help our Missions to flourish. We are preparing translations of our liturgical texts complete with careful English translations of ancient Syriac hymns. Last summer we ordained two new priests, Vince Farhat and Dany Abi Akar, and we welcomed Therese Touma into the new religious community for women Maronite Servants of Christ the Light, founded by God's Holy Spirit and Sister Marla Marie Lucas.

Each year we assist our Patriarch and Bishops in Lebanon to reach out to the poor. Four years ago we began an official program of financial accountability and transparency in the Chancery including all our parishes and institutions. We embark on the preparatory phase for a first ever Eparchial Capital Campaign to ensure the financial viability of the Eparchy. This year we will send three new priests to serve Missions who have been waiting and working for their day to have a priest!

We do this because of your confidence and generosity. Yet we have so much more to do. Please open your hearts, once again, to help your Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn to fulfill its God-given imperative to make known the face of Christ in the world. Your donation to our annual appeal is greatly appreciated and much needed.

Stations of the Cross

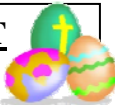

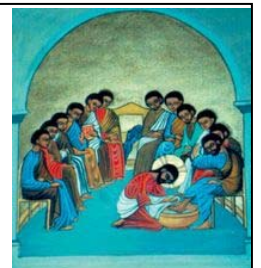


Confession during Lent

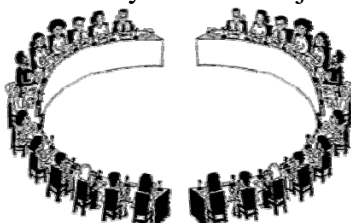

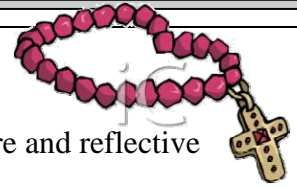

St Anthony Scholarship 2011

Graduation Awards Descriptions and Eligibility Criteria

Dear Parishioners,

June and the season for graduation is almost upon us. In years past, the members of St. Anthony parish have made a strong commitment to our graduating seniors with its established scholarship program. The committee this year has adopted some revised criteria for the giving of monetary awards to the young people of our parish who are graduating from secondary schools. We believe that every graduating high school senior who is a member in good standing of our church community and his/her Maronite faith deserve the recognition and support of the parish family. The goal of the committee is to ensure that each of these young people receives a “St. Anthony Graduation Gift” in recognition of the completion of requirements for graduation and in recognition of their accomplishments and service to our community of faith and to the community at large. There are, therefore, three separate categories for awards which are described as following:

1. St. Anthony Graduation Gift

The Graduation Gift will be given to all graduating high school seniors from St. Anthony parish who are members in good standing of the church community and in his/her Maronite faith. The Graduation Gift will be awarded in recognition of the student’s completion of the requirements for graduation from secondary school. The Graduation Gift is given to show that our parish community supports and takes pride in our secondary school graduates. Funding for the Graduation Gift comes from the St. Anthony Scholarship Fund. The monetary amount of the “**St. Anthony Graduation Gift**” may vary from year to year according to the discretion of the pastor of St. Anthony, the Parish Council, and the Graduation Committee.

Criteria

- Graduation from secondary school
- Member in good standing of St. Anthony parish

2. St. Anthony MYO Scholarship

The MYO Scholarship will be given to graduating seniors who are MYO members in good standing of the church community and in his/her faith and who have demonstrated outstanding service to the MYO activities. Funding for the MYO Scholarships comes from money raised by the MYO.

Criteria

- Graduation from secondary school
- Member in good standing of St. Anthony parish
- Membership in St. Anthony MYO and a demonstrated commitment to parish and community service

3. Scholarship/Award Given in Memory/Honor of an Individual

A special scholarship/award can be created and donated by parish members who wish to honor or remember someone. The scholarships/awards which have been established in memory of a particular person will be given to the graduating senior(s) who fulfill the criteria established for that scholarship. Funding for these scholarships comes from money donated for this purpose. Criteria are determined by the family or persons granting that award.

All eligible graduating seniors who wish to be considered for any of these awards are asked to complete the application which will be made available to them from Father Jean Younes or on-line at www.stanthonydanbury.com. Please return completed applications to Father Jean by May 12, 2011. Interviews will be on Wednesday May 25 from 6 to 7:30 pm at the Rectory.

We hope that this letter clarifies the particular awards and scholarships that are given out to our graduates and we hope you will join us to honor them on Father's Day, June 19, 2011 after 10:00 am Liturgy.


